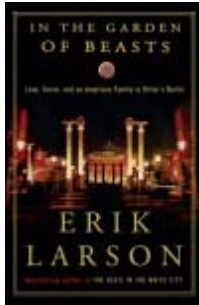


B'nai Tikvah Sisterhood Book Club
